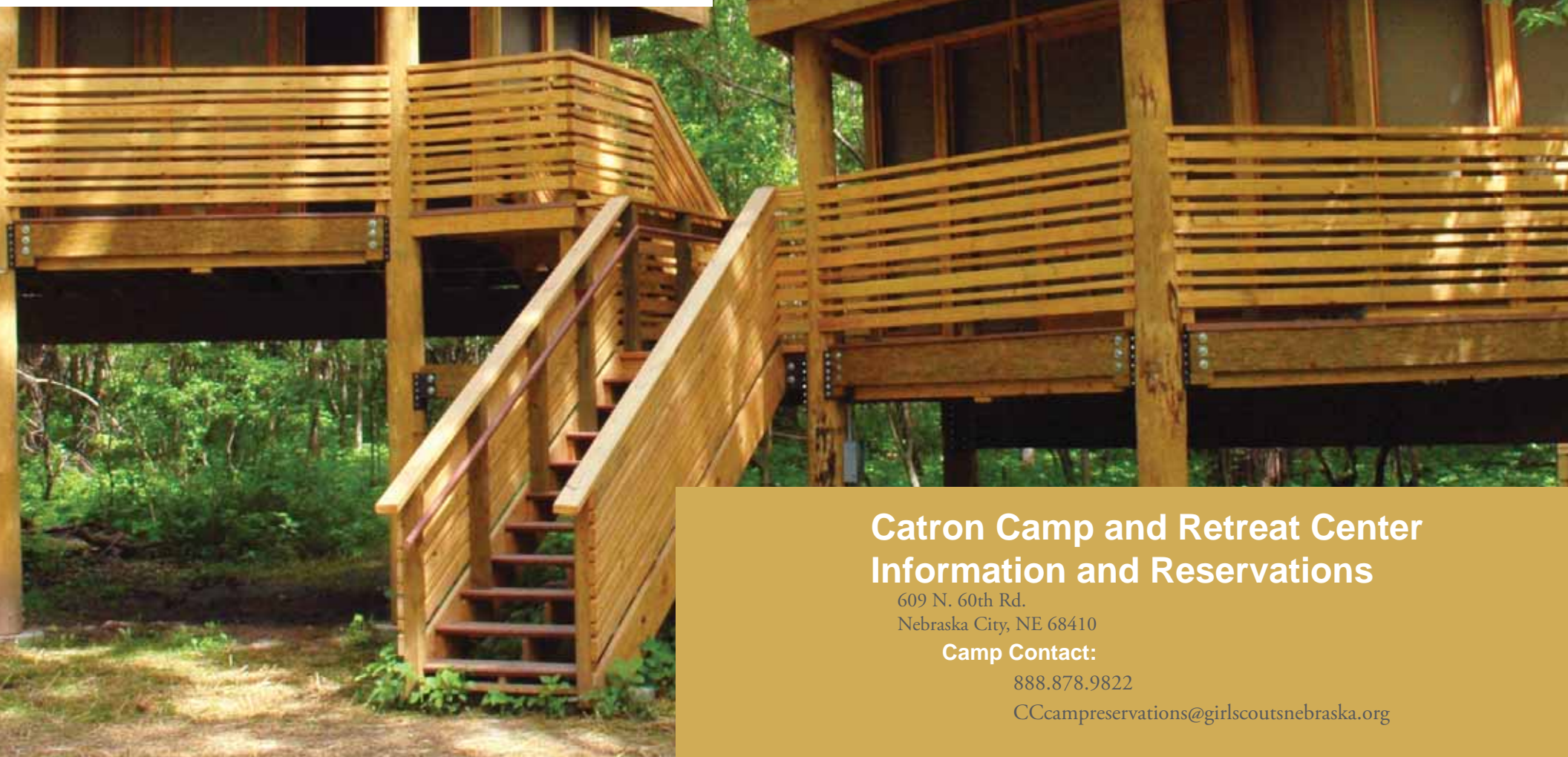

## Sky Camp

at Trails End is nestled among large oak trees, with eight elevated, screened-in tree houses that each sleep four. One of the tree houses is ADA accessible. Accommodations at Sky Camp include: a new, accessible, multi-shower and restroom storm shelter, fire circle, cooking pavilion, water and refrigerator.



## Sherwood Forest and Indian Village

tent sites are available for use during warm weather. Accommodations include: fire circle, cooking pavilion and shower house (no outhouses).



## Teambuilding Courses – Zip Line

High and low challenge courses help groups build confidence, teamwork and problem-solving skills, trust, coordination and appreciation of the natural world. We will provide a trained employee or volunteer when you schedule. The zip line is part of the high challenge course and there are age/height requirements. Both high and low courses are closed during winter.

## Swimming Pool

Catron has a large pool with a zero-entry ramp and accessible shower house. Pool is open Memorial Day to Labor Day. A lifeguard is included in the price of rental and will be provided for your event.

## Trails

Numerous trails have been created throughout Catron. Some trails are covered with wood chips (groomed) and have been routed through Catron's most beautiful natural areas, including a trail crossing crystal clear Walnut Creek.

## Environmental Education Workshops (EEWs)

These workshops are offered throughout the year and are age specific. Enjoy two hours of a guided, hands-on activity that will focus on the outdoors; geared for any age level.

## Archery

Archery equipment is available for ages 10 and older. A certified archery instructor is required and can be provided for an additional charge.

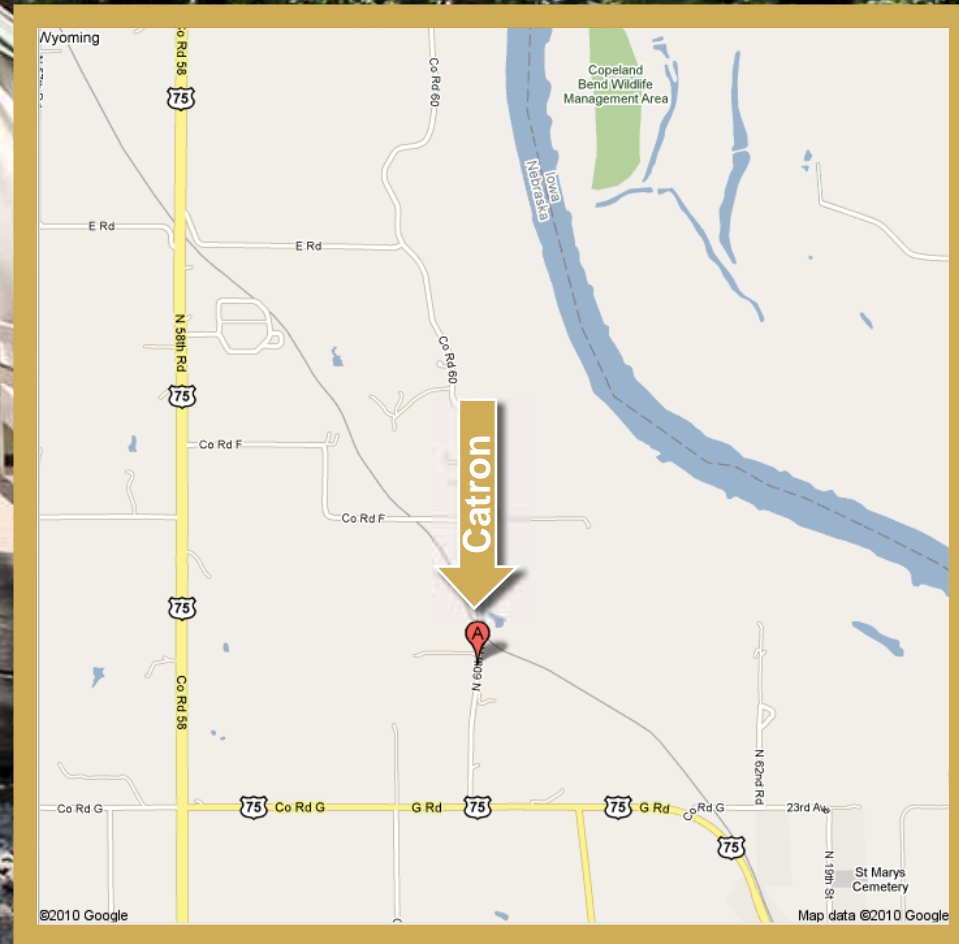






## Additional Features:
