



Give a Gift of Life Insurance

If you are considering a contribution to Girl Scouts Spirit of Nebraska, the gift of a life insurance policy might be a very good way to provide a larger gift after death than you are currently able to do.

By naming Girl Scouts Spirit of Nebraska as beneficiary and assigning ownership, you will receive an income-tax charitable deduction. If you stop paying the policy premiums, your available cash is increased and if you make the gift and also continue paying the policy premiums, you will be able to claim the premium amount as an annual tax deduction. The proceeds are then completely removed from your taxable estate.

Another option would be to name Girl Scouts Spirit of Nebraska as a contingent beneficiary in case your primary beneficiary predeceases you. No current income tax deduction would be available in this situation.
